TO SHREWSBURY \longrightarrow

Founded over thirty years ago, the SJ Roberts Group, with its headquarters on the Shropshire/ Powys border has a turnover of over £20 million reassuring new home buyers they are contracting with an established business with an excellent local reputation.

About Shrewsbury

With a population of around 75,000 Shrewsbury is the county town for Shropshire. Set amidst glorious countryside near to the Welsh borders, it is one of England's finest medieval market towns. The stunning town centre is packed with timber-framed black and white buildings, steep narrow streets and alleyways all home to independent shops, high street retailers, bars and cafes - making it a beautiful yet lively and social town.

The River Severn forms a loop around the town centre, offering riverside walks or pleasure boat trips. Renowned as the 'town of flowers' Shrewsbury was awarded Gold in the 2016 Heart of England in Bloom competition highlighting the beauty of Quarry Park, location for the annual Shrewsbury Flower Show.

ALL STREET

If you are new to the county you will quickly see that Shrewsbury is easily accessible by road as it is connected to the M6 and motorway network via the M54. Sweetlake Meadow is also ideally located to take advantage of the county's rail network with direct routes running north to Chester, Manchester, Crewe and Wrexham, south to Hereford and Cardiff, west to Aberystwyth, and east to Birmingham, plus a direct rail service to London Euston taking just over 2 ¹/₂ hours.

Local Schools

Two of Shropshire's top rated state-funded secondary schools – the Priory and Meole Brace – are located within walking distance of Sweetlake Meadow. The county also offers a first class range of Independent schools.

The Priory School, rated as 'Outstanding' by Ofsted (last inspection 2013) is a Business and Enterprise Academy for 11 to 16 year olds. Its 850 pupils consistently achieve results well above the national average, with 78% achieving 5 A* - C GCSEs (or equivalents) including English and Maths.

Meole Brace School, rated as 'Good' by Ofsted (last inspected 2015) is a Science College for 11 to 16 year olds with over 1200 pupils. In its latest Ofsted report 72% of parents strongly agreed with the statement 'my child is happy at this school', set against the national average of 42% it clearly demonstrates the school's principal aim to enable its pupils to lead happy and successful lives, both at school and when they leave. The school also achieves good academic results with 64% of its pupils achieving 5 A* - C GCSEs (or equivalents).

There are two primary schools – Meole Brace and Radbook – located within walking distance of Sweetlake Meadow, both rated as 'Good' by Ofsted.

At Sweetlake Meadow our new homes are expertly designed to be energy efficient, to maximise natural light and to provide generous storage, whether you are buying a 2, 3 or 4 bedroom home.

Kitchens

Recognising that 'Inline' kitchens are a must-have style for today's modern home, your new kitchen cupboards include a handle trim to the top of drawers and doors to create an uncluttered linear style kitchen.

These innovative and stylish kitchens are supplied by market leader Symphony, with gloss and matt finished units arranged in a contemporary 'Mix & Match' style.

To compliment the sleek lines of this design, low profile sinks are included as standard, together with a low profile ceramic or induction hob, all set in a premium 38mm deep worktop. Integrated, eye level single or double ovens are stacked in a contemporary style for ease of use and access.

Bathrooms

Your new home is fitted with modern contemporary white sanitaryware with white acrylic baths. Complementary wall and floor tiles are supplied by Porcelanosa, the Spanish company recognised across the globe as a leading supplier of quality ceramic tiles.

All showers are fitted with a thermostatic control, ensuring you have a constant flow of hot water.



Internal:

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- The walls of your new home at Sweetlake Meadow are painted throughout in Crown Soft Steel, a light grey emulsion, with ceilings in brilliant white;
- Your new home is fitted with modern Burford style skirting and architrave finished in hardwearing eggshell white;
- At Sweetlake Meadow, the new homes are fitted with uPVC double-glazed windows and patio doors throughout, supplied by Munster Joinery one of the largest manufacturers of energy efficient windows and doors in Europe.



External:

- Exterior lighting to the front and rear of your home is included as standard;
- Rear gardens are seeded, with privacy created by brick walls and/or 1800mm close boarded fencing;
- All front gardens are turfed and landscaped;
- Driveways are block paved, with patio and pathways laid in a textured grey patio slab.

In addition, it is the most environmentally sustainable way to build new homes, also delivering enhanced thermal properties reducing heating costs.

Our timber frames have FSC[®] & PEFC[™] certifications ensuring that our timber is purchased from sustainable sources.

Your new timber frame home is recognised by major mortgage lenders as a mainstream method of construction and as an approved building system by the LABC & NHBC.



Provided by LABC your new home is covered for a wide range of structural defects that could, although rarely, occur during the first ten years after your home is completed.

This means that structural faults that may happen during this time period will be taken care of with the minimum of fuss. What's more, you don't need to do a thing to ensure your property is adequately covered. SJ Roberts Homes has already arranged and paid for this before you buy your home and will provide you with a Certificate of Insurance on handover.
